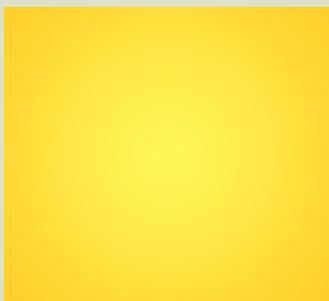

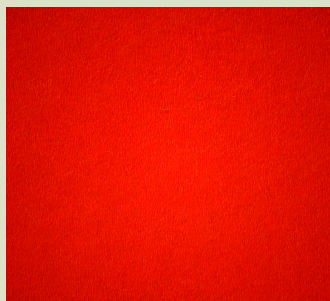

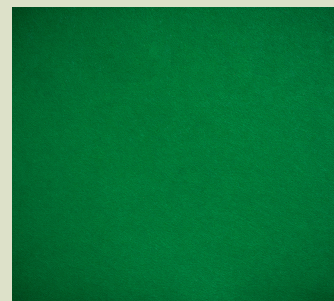
- Glenoaks Golf Shirt (for sports day and walkathon learners must please wear their house colour – yellow (Topaz), red (Ruby) or green (Emerald))

Uniform Other

- Hair must at all times be neat, respectfully groomed and not hinder or distract self/others from work or school purposes. Hair ties must be navy, black, clear or white.
- Religious attire may be worn. Please consult with the school in this regard.
- Jewellery may not be worn. Wrist watches are permitted (not smart watches). Medic-alert bracelets are permitted. Watches for seizure or other medical safety reasons must be brought to the school's attention. Jewellery with a religious or cultural significance may be worn inconspicuously.
- Girls may wear plain studs or sleepers, only one earring in each ear lobe.
- No other body piercings will be permitted.
- No tattoos are permitted. If a learner already has a tattoo it must be concealed.
- No make-up, permanent make up or eyelash extensions are permitted.
- Nails must be kept manageable (not protruding beyond the flesh of fingertips). Clear nail varnish is permitted.
